

**Meeting of the City of London Law Society Competition Law Committee
held at 12:30pm on 18 May 2023 in person and via videoconference**

Minutes

Committee members were joined by guest speakers from Department for Business and Trade (DBT) and Department for Science Innovation and Technology (DSIT), who provided a general overview of the Digital Markets, Competition and Consumers Bill (DMCC Bill) and its introduction. The meeting included discussion about:

- The anticipated timing and regulatory path for the DMCC Bill.
- The digital aspects of the DMCC and in particular – how it is envisaged that the SMS designation process will work in practice; the extent to which the digital regime will interplay with existing merger control powers; and the scope of the DMU's powers.
- The consumer aspects of the DMCC and in particular – the role that the CMA will take in this new regime; the way in which these decisions can be appealed; the CMA's next steps in terms of guidance; and the current approach to consumer law.
- The competition law aspects of the DMCC and in particular – the new merger control thresholds; the revisions to the CMA's enforcement powers; and extra-territoriality provisions.
