Updated Guidance for In-house Solicitors

Thursday 28th November 2024, 4.00 p.m.

The SRA is publishing updated guidance for in-house solicitors, who account for around a quarter of all solicitors. It addresses the unique challenges and issues facing in-house solicitors working across a range of employers and sectors.

The guidance was developed following requests from the profession and issues identified in a thematic review and covers a range of areas including identifying the client, reporting concerns of wrong-doing and legal professional privilege. Alongside the updated guidance, the session will also cover other areas of the SRA's work to support in-house solicitors.
